TASTED MEDIUM DEEP RUBY RED COLOUR. PURE NOSE DISPLAYING RED AND DARK FRUIT WITH SOME
ANDREAS LARSSON LEAFY NOTES, TOBACCO, DISCREET OAK AND AROMATIC HERBS. MEDIUM WEIGHT ON THE
90/100 PALATE, YOUTHFUL BUT BALANCED, STILL WITH A TANNIC BITE, GOOD GRIP AND LENGTH WITH
NOTES OF WILD BERRY FRUIT AND MILD SPICES ON THE FINISH.

LE FIGARO THE COLOR IS DARK AND THE NOSE IS VERY INTENSE, EXUBERANT EVEN WITH NOTES OF
BERNARD BURTSCHY COFFEE AND WOOD. THE WINE IS OF GOOD DENSITY, SUPPLE, CHARMING, FAR FROM ITS
17/20 USUAL FIRMNESS THAT CONFIRMS THE GOOD DISPOSITIONS OF 2014. CHARMING.

92/100 SOMEWHAT LIQUEUR AND FAT, CHOCOLATY, A LITTLE VINTAGE PORT, MINERAL ON THE FINISH,
SWEET AFTERTASTE.

CLASSIC AND FRESH, VERY ENGAGING WITH A GREEDY FINISH.

JAMES SUCKLING THIS IS A ST. ÉMILION 2015 WITH A VERY RICH PALATE AND LOTS OF VELVETY TANNINS. IT'S
93/100 FULL BODY AND SAVORY. CHEWY. A LITTLE OVER EXTRACTED BUT SHOWS POTENTIAL.

JANCIS ROBINSON DEEPISSH CRIMSON. LESS EXPRESSIVE THAN CHATEAU BALESTARD LA TONNELLE, SOME OAKY
16/20 SPICE. TANNINS ARE ROUNDED BUT QUITE CHEWY AND DOMINATE THE FRUIT AT THE MOMENT
BUT SHOULD ALL COME INTO PLACE IN BOTTLE. NOT PARTICULARLY PERSISTENT.

PERSWIJN WARM, PLUM, CHERRY, FLORAL, LUSH AND JUICY, FINE FRUIT AND WOOD

BORDEAUX TOTAL THIS IS A ST. ÉMILION 2015 WITH A VERY RICH PALATE AND LOTS OF VELVETY TANNINS. IT'S
RENÉ GABRIEL FULL BODY AND SAVORY. CHEWY. A LITTLE OVER EXTRACTED BUT SHOWS POTENTIAL.

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THE WINE ADVOCATE MEDIUM GARNET-PURPLE IN COLOR, THE 2015 CAP DE MOURLIN OPENS WITH BRIGHT, VIBRANT RED FRUITS WITH BLACKBERRY ACCENTS AND EARTHY UNDERTONES. MEDIUM TO FULL-BODIED WITH SOFT, SUPPLE, APPROACHABLE TANNINS AND PLENTY OF FRESHNESS, IT FINISHES ON AN EARTHY NOTE. DRINKING WELL NOW, IT SHOULD EASILY CELLAR FOR 10-12 YEARS.

THE WINE CELLAR INSIDER SMOKY WITH PLUMS CHERRY AND HERBAL ESSENCES ARE ON THE NOSE. ON THE PALATE, ESPRESSO BEAN, SMOKE, EARTH, BLACK CHERRIES AND LICORICE BURST OUT OF THE STARTING GATE. THIS WINE IS SOFT, POLISHED, ROUND LEAVES YOU WITH FRESH, SALTY PLUMS IN THE FINISH.

VERT DE VIN THE NOSE IS FRUITY, FRESH, AROMATIC AND QUITE CONCENTRATED. THERE ARE NOTES OF PLUM, BLACKCURRANT, WOOD AND MOCHA ASSOCIATED WITH FINE NOTES OF LICORICE AND DISCREET NOTES OF UNDERGROWTH. THE PALATE IS FRUITY, BALANCED, ELEGANT AND OFFERS MINERALITY/FRESHNESS, ACIDITY AND A NICE JUICINESS. IN THE MOUTH THIS WINE EXPRESSES BLACKBERRY, BLACKCURRANT AND FINE BLUEBERRY NOTES ASSOCIATED WITH HINTS OF CHOCOLATE AS WELL AS A BACKGROUND OF PLUM AND A TOUCH OF SWEET SPICE/TOAST.NICE LENGTH AND PERSISTENCE.

TASTING BOOK DARK PURPLE RED WITH VIOLET HUE AND BLACK CORE. VERY INTENSE NOSE WITH OPULENT CHARACTER, BALMY SPICES, RIPE FRUITS, PLUM JAM, BLACKBERRIES AND SWEET ELDERBERRIES. ON THE PALATE, WELL-BALANCED AND STRUCTURED WITH FIRM BUT MATURE TANNINS, JUICY FRUIT BUT ALSO A HINT OF ASTRINGENCY IN THE FINISH. VERY PROMISING PONTENTIAL.
