FALSTAFF DEEP DARK RUBY GARNET, VIOLET REFLECTIONS, DELICATE RIM BRIGHTENING, INTENSE PETER MOSER BLACKCURRANT, HINTS OF LICORICE AND CASSIS, CANDIED CITRUS ZEST. JUICY, FRESH, RED 90/100 BERRY, FINE TANNINS, MINERAL-SALTY FINISH, ALREADY DRINKABLE, GASTRONOMIC STYLE.

GUIDE GAULT ET MILLAU SMOKY, SPICY, VERY WOODY NOSE, TANNIC AND MODERATELY DENSE MOUTH, A STRUCTURE 16/20 ON THE TENSION, TANNINS WHICH TIGHTEN A LITTLE IN FINALE

JAMES SUCKLING BRASSY RED PLUMS AND A GENTLY CEDARY EDGE TO THE NOSE HERE. THE PALATE HAS AN 92/100 ELEGANT FEEL WITH A FRESH AND TAUT CORE OF RED PLUMS. DRINK OR HOLD.

JANCIS ROBINSON DEEP AND SMUDGY BLACK CHERRY COLOUR. SWEET AND LIFTED ON THE NOSE, CHERRY 16/20 SCENTED, PRETTY AND INVITING, JUICY, MOREISH, FRESH, THE TANNINS WELL JUDGED.

MATTHEW JUKES THIS IS A SOUR WINE AND THE OAK HAS DAMPENED THE FRUIT SOMEWHAT WHICH IS A SHAME 16+/20 BECAUSE THERE ARE SOME WORTHY BLACK CHERRY TONES HERE AND THE WEIGHT SEEMS FINE. TOO. THERE IS A TOASTY NOTE WHICH CLASHES WITH THE CORE AND THIS IS UNFORTUNATE. IT ALSO SEEMS TO HIGHLIGHT SOME OF THE GREENER NOTES WHICH ARE PRESENT.

THE WINE ADVOCATE MEDIUM TO DEEP GARNET-PURPLE COLORED, THE 2017 CAP DE MOURLIN DELIVERS NOTES LISA PERROTTI-BROWN OF BAKED BLACK CHERRIES, BLACK RASPBERRIES AND PLUM PRESERVES WITH HINTS OF SPICE 93+/100 CAKE, POTPOURRI, FOREST FLOOR AND SMOKED MEATS. MEDIUM TO FULL-BODIED, THE PALATE IS PACKED WITH SPICY BLACK FRUITS, FRAMED BY VELVETY TANNINS AND A LIVELY LINE, FINISHING LONG.









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TIM ATKIN RICH OAKY AND DEEP AROMAS. SOFT FRUIT, SPICY TANNINS. RICH AND SPICY, DRY AND 16/20 RICH BLACK FRUIT. NO GREENNESS, BUT FRESH AND ROUNDED. PRETTY GOOD.

BLUEBERRY/PINK, SMALL TOUCHES OF LICORICE, CARAMELIZATION AS WELL AS A VERY

DISCREET HINT OF CHOCOLATE AND GREY PEPPER (IN THE BACKGROUND). THE PALATE IS

FRESH, RACY AND OFFERS JUICINESS, FATNESS, GOOD DEFINITION, A NICE FINENESS OF

GRAIN, A FINE UNCTUOUSNESS, ROUNDNESS, VOLUME, A FINE POWER AND TENSION. ON THE

PALATE, THIS WINE EXPRESSES NOTES OF BLACKCURRANT, WILD STRAWBERRY AND SLIGHTLY

FLESHY RASPBERRY ASSOCIATED WITH FINE BLACK CHERRY, LICORICE AND A TOUCH OF

COFFEE AND ZAN/TOBACCO. THE TANNINS ARE FINE AND A BIT FIRM. SMALL BITTERNESS ON

THE FINISH.

WEINWISSER THE DARKEST PURPLE OF THE DAY WITH OPAQUE CENTER AND BLACK HIGHLIGHTS.

17/20 CONCENTRATED BOUQUET WITH PIEDMONT CHERRY AND PLUM SKIN, BACKED BY LICORICE AND WILD BERRY TEA. PALATE WITH MASSIVE TANNIN FRAMEWORK, MEALY TANNINS AND UNPLEASANT ACIDITY. BUNDLED FINISH WITH TANNED MULBERRY SKIN AND STRONG ASTRINGENCY. HOPEFULLY IT CAN DIGEST THIS.

TASTING BOOK DARK PURPLE RED WITH VIOLET HUE AND BLACK CORE. EXPRESIVE NOSE WITH

MARKUS DEL MONEGO CONCENTRATEDFRUIT REMINISCENT OF MULBERRIES AND ELDERBERRIES, COCOA AND MOCHA.
