TASTING BOOK DARK PURPLE RED WITH VIOLET HUE AND BLACK CORE. AROMATIC NOSE WITH DISTINCT MARKUS DEL MONEGO AROMAS, BACKED BY MILD SPICES AND DARK BERRIES. ON THE PALATE WELL BALANCED 92/100 WITH RIPE TANNINS, GOOD AROMATIC LENGH.

THE WINE ADVOCATE VERY DEEP PURPLE-BLACK COLORED, THE 2019 CAP DE MOURLIN EXPLODES FROM THE GLASS LISA PERROTTI-BROWN WITH BOMBASTIC NOTES OF BAKED PLUMS, WARM BLACKBERRIES AND BLACK FOREST CAKE 92-94/100 PLUS HINTS OF LICORICE, UNSMOKED CIGARS AND CEDAR CHEST WITH A TOUCH OF GARRIGUE, MEDIUM TO FULL-BODIED, THE PALATE IS REASSURINGLY SAVORY, WITH LOADS OF SPICE AND DRIED HERBS NOTIONS ACCENTING THE BLACK FRUITS AND FRAMED BY RIPE, ROUNDED TANNINS, FINISHING WONDERFULLY REFRESHING.

VINOUS MAGAZINE POWERFUL, BURLY WINE. FIRM TANNINS, WRAP AROUND A CORE OF DENSE DARK FRUIT IN THIS ANTONIO GALLONI VIRILE, INCISIVE SAINT-ÉMILION DONE IN AN EXTRACTED STYLE. THERE IS GOOD DEPTH AND 90/100 PERSISTANCE HERE, BUT SOME OF THE MORE ANGULAR CONTOURS NEED TO SOFTEN IN ORDER FOR THE 2019 TO EXPRESS ALL OF ITS POTENTIAL, CEDAR, SWEET TOBACCO, TORREFACTION, MINT AND DARK CHERRY BUILD INTO THE PERSISTENT FINISH.

JAMES SUCKLING LOTS OF RIPE FRUIT WITH CHOCOLATE AND WALNUTS, AS WELL AS CURRANTS AND BERRIES. 94-95/100 IT'S FULL-BODIED WITH JUICY TANNINS AND AN INTENSE FINISH, VERY LAYERED.

DECANTER PLUMMY FRUIT, CHEWY TANNINS, A BEAT AWAY FROM RUSTIC BUT STAYING ON THE RIGHT SIDE JANE ANSON OF THE LINE. THE HIGH PROPORTION OF CABERNET SSUVIGNON NO DOUBT PARTLY EXPLAINS 90/100 THE SLIGHTLY SOMBRE FEELING HERE, WITH SAVOURY FRUITS AND A FIRM STRUCTURE.
